





to set up a new password for the camera to view the video.



STEP 4 - CABLING Use the diagram below to connect power, network and external devices such as audio input and output, alarm and sensors to the camera.

a. Check the box next to the camera. b. Click "Bulk Password Assign" on the left. c. Enter admin/admin for the current username and password. Enter a new username and password to the right. Password must have at least eight (8) characters and at least four (4) combinations of uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers and special characters. Passwords cannot contain the user ID.
