WATERPROOF CAP INSTALLATION The waterproof cap set comes with two rubber rings. Use the rubber ring best sized for your network cable's diameter. Cables with ø4.5mm to ø5.5mm thickness should use the black rubber ring. Cables over ø5.5mm in thickness should use the white NOTE: To ensure moisture seal, make sure the o-ring (1) is in place between **6** and **6**.
